| Truth Pharm                                    | Lauren took the initiative. Alexis Pleus is willing to come and will only ask for travel reimbursement. She gave 2 possible dates. She has a PowerPoint. To present and field Q & A felt she needed at least an hour. Lauren sent this email response to Jackie Shrader, Kris Schiek and Ann Marie Flanagan. Suggested that it be on the same day as the whole YSAC meets so that those attending could be as informed as possible. Lauren had contacted Mike Ballard and Jamie_____ for approval. Lauren emailed members to inform that Alexis will be here on 10/26, our regular meeting night. | Need for services                              | Doug had reported that he had someone who wanted help. He called FLACRA himself because the person he was helping was afraid he would not remain anonymous. At August's full coalition meeting, FLACRA members shared a success story. They also noted that their Addictions Crisis Center in Clifton Springs offers next/same day assistance, but the nurse manager of it said many are refusing the offer, possibly because of the need to become enrolled in the program/losing anonymity? Sandie questioned what it would take to get in-jail support if the person is detoxing versus a trip to the ER.   |
| Detox Center                                   | Lauren added that this type of resource is needed immediately. (Related to above entry.)   |
| Drug Court                                     | It was reported that there is no limit to the number of participants. Typically it is 15-21 individuals.   |
| Supported living                               | Not enough here. At the full coalition meeting it was revealed that Lakeview Mental Health has transitional housing (30 days) for anyone coming out of jail or the hospital. What will it take to get more?  |
| Suboxone                                       | From the full coalition meeting: Dr. Dewitt needs to inject it 1-2 days before an inmate is released, otherwise it is not yet effective. Some wondered if there is a way to screen for when an inmate is ripe for change.  |
